FROM RENO/TAHOE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT to HOTEL

Transfer by Taxi

Approximate Cost: \$140 for a one way transfer

Transfer by Shuttle

Approximate Cost: \$40 per person for a one way transfer

By Car

The estimated travel time by car from Reno/Tahoe International Airport is 50 minutes. Please be advised that these are mountain roads. You will pass the Mount Rose Ski Resort and beautiful views of Lake Tahoe.

Reno-Tahoe International Airport provides convenient access to eight different rental car agencies. Alamo, Avis, Budget, Dollar, Enterprise, Hertz, and National vehicles are located just outside Baggage Claim in the Parking Structure. Advantage and Thrifty vehicles are located off the airport.

1. From the airport exit, go WEST on E. PLUMB LANE toward US 395 South. 0.1 mi
2. Merge onto US-395 S via the ramp on the LEFT toward CARSON CITY. 8.1 mi
3. Merge onto NV-431/MT ROSE HWY via EXIT 56, where the freeway ends, toward MT ROSE/NO LAKE TAHOE. 24.2 mi
4. When NV-431 ends at a "T", turn LEFT onto Tahoe Blvd (Highway 28) 2.0 mi
5. Turn right at Country Club Drive. 0.5 mi
6. The Hyatt is on the right at the "T" with Lakeshore Blvd, at 111 Country Club Drive.
